Questions & Answers

Revised answers to questions #2 and #72 are provided below..

2. If our company consists of multiple divisions, can each division submit a separate proposal or must we propose as one company? Could each division receive a separate award?

Each Division may submit a separate proposal for award consideration. It is possible that each Division within a company may receive an award. However, Offerors are cautioned that if one company submits separate proposals from multiple Divisions, each Division's proposal should address the full RFP requirements uniquely based on their particular Division's capabilities. For example, management processes, small business participation plans, and/or past performance submissions of a different Division may not be used in support of the Division submitting the proposal. The proposal must be specific to the Division submitting the proposal.

72. PEOSTRI provided an answer that "Any Company/Division with its own CAGE Code may submit a proposal for award consideration. It is possible that multiple divisions within a given company may each receive separate awards."

Our question is if one Division were to be eliminated, does that also eliminate any other Division of that company that also proposed?

If one Division's proposal is "eliminated," that does not automatically "eliminate" the other Division's proposal. The Government will evaluate each proposal separately based on its own merits.
