**LETTER REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)**  
**AND INSTRUCTIONS TO OFFERORS**

**Target Modernization and Targetry Range Automated Control and  
Recording (TRACR) Post Deployment Software Support (PDSS) / Post  
Production Software Support (PPSS)**

The Government will satisfy the requirements set forth herein via the contracts awarded under the U.S. Army PEO STRI Common Army Ranges and Target Systems (CARTS) Indefinite Delivery / Indefinite Quantity (ID/IQ) contract, Lot II, Range Systems, Engineering and Integration. Award of a Cost Plus Fixed Fee Delivery Order is planned for award on or around March 2012 subject to FAR 52.232-18 Availability of Funds. This Delivery Order will be issued in accordance with the CARTS Statement of Work (SOW), Paragraph 3.2 and as further defined by the TRACR PDSS / PPSS SOW provided in Attachment (1) of this Request For Proposals (RFP). All terms and conditions of the basic CARTS contracts awarded will remain in effect for this Delivery Order. This letter and enclosures shall serve as the Government's formal RFP to satisfy the effort described herein.

**Requirement**

The Government has a requirement to support the Target Modernization program for the sustainment and support of the Government owned common target control system (TRACR); integration of legacy target system adapters and new target system technologies; upgrade to existing range facilities; support for new interface control documents and technology demonstrations; and sustainment of the Future Army System of Integrated Targets (FASIT) specification and standards. The Government also has a requirement to ensure that all work efforts and tasks shall be synchronized across the individual PDSS/ PPSS efforts and with the Consolidated Product Line Management (CPM) construct, tools, and methods.

Refer to the Representative Task Matrix and Representative Aperiodic Task (Attachments (2) and (3) of the RFP) for further clarification of potential work in support of TRACR PDSS / PPSS. These lists are not all-inclusive.

Award will be made in accordance with the evaluation criteria set forth in Attachment (10) of the RFP.
