**Aviation Targets for Digital Range Training Systems (DRTS)**

The Government will satisfy the requirements set forth herein via the contracts awarded under the U.S. Army PEO STRI Common Army Ranges and Target Systems (CARTS) Indefinite Delivery / Indefinite Quantity (ID/IQ) contract, Lot III, Target Silhouettes. Award of a Firm Fixed Price Delivery Order with an incidental Time and Material (T&M) line item is planned for award on or around 13 July 2012 subject to FAR 52.232-18 Availability of Funds. This Delivery Order will be issued in accordance with the CARTS Statement of Work (SOW), Paragraph 3.3 and as further defined by the Aviation Targets SOW provided in Attachment (1) of this Request For Proposal (RFP). All terms and conditions of the basic CARTS contracts awarded will remain in effect for this Delivery Order. This letter and enclosures shall serve as the Government's formal RFP to satisfy the effort described herein.

**Requirement**

The Government has a requirement to procure hardware targetry (range devices/components), for the Aviation Add-On Package/Air Ground Integration (AGI) Village for Ft Carson, CO, Yakima Training Area, Washington, and Ft Bliss, Texas Digital Air Ground Integration Ranges (DAGIRs).

**Basis for Award**

The award will be made utilizing the Lowest Price Technically Acceptable (LPTA) Source Selection Process. Award will be made in accordance with the evaluation criteria set forth in Attachments 3 (Proposal Submission Instructions) and 4 (Requirements Matrix) of the solicitation. Please note that mere reiteration of the requirement or standard reference material is discouraged. It is the offeror's responsibility to present enough information to be meaningfully evaluated without discussions. In presenting material in this proposal, offerors are advised that quality of information is more important than quantity.


