The Government will satisfy the requirements set forth herein via the contracts awarded under the U.S. Army Program Executive Office for Simulation, Training and Instrumentation (PEO STRI) STOC II Multiple Award contract, Lot I. Award of a Firm Fixed price Delivery Order is planned for award no later than 29 March 2013, subject to FAR 52.232-18 Availability of Funds. This Delivery Order will be issued in accordance with the STOC II Statement of Work (SOW), and as further defined by the SOW for the Serbia Multiple Integrated Laser Engagement System (MILES) provided as Attachment (1) of this Request for Proposals (RFP). All terms and conditions of the basic STOC II contracts awarded will remain in effect for this Delivery Order. This letter and enclosure shall serve as the Government's RFP to satisfy the effort described herein.

Requirement

PEO STRI, Project Manager for Training Devices (PM TRADE) has a Foreign Military Sales (FMS) requirement to procure approximately a 1-company-size set of Multiple Integrated Laser Engagement System IWS (MILES-IWS) and associated hardware/equipment to supplement/enhance the existing Serbian Combat Training Center (CTC) capability.
