Amendment 02 to Solicitation No. STOCII-13-KOL-0005 dated 7 Jan 2013 is issued to answer the below question received in response to Solicitation STOC II-13-KOL-0005 Amendment 001:

1. With the addition of the IWS and TVS specs, as well as the definition of TRL and MRL, does this require us to provide evidence that we meet the specs and have proven the minimum acceptable TRL and MRLs?

**Government response - See Paragraph 2 under Section L - Technical**

**(2) The offeror shall complete the Requirements Matrix (Attachment 4) which clearly demonstrates how their product meets the requirements. All requirements must be met. Offerors shall identify, in the notes section of the Requirements Checklist(s), the page number of the proposal that demonstrates how their product(s) meet the Government requirement. Failure to meet a Government stated requirement may deem the offeror's proposal unacceptable; which may render an offeror ineligible for award. It is incumbent upon each offeror to provide documentation that clearly supports the offeror's ability to meet the requirements of the SOW.**

This amendment does not change the requirements of the RFP. The RFP closing date and time remain unchanged.
