Amendment 03 to Solicitation No. STOCII-13-KOL-0005 dated 7 Jan 2013 is issued to answer the below questions and to extend the proposal submission date to 11 February 2013 by no-later-than 4:00 P.M. The offeror instructions and evaluation Criteria has been revised to reflect the extended submission date.

1. **Question:** In section 3.4.9, the SOW requires a 12 month defect/workmanship warranty after in-country final acceptance test with an option of a second year. The 2nd year warranty option is not listed in Section B. Please clarify the warranty requirements in this Solicitation along with the statement that the contractor "shall ensure the repaired equipment for the standard life cycle support services already provided by contractor via the firm-fixed priced contract".

Government response – The language in SOW paragraph 3.4.9 will be revised upon award to reflect the requirement to repair or replace all latent defects identified in section C, paragraph C.2 as prescribed below:

- "The repair or replacement of all latent defects (bumper-to-bumper) in material and workmanship from time of acceptance at origin to include any export/import licenses fees for which the contractor is responsible for obtaining, and cost of shipping to/from country for items delivered under this CLIN. The contractor shall repair or replace all latent defects for a period of twelve (12) months starting at the time of in-country acceptance."
2. In SOW 3.4.4, the requirements state that the contractor is only required to identify tools and test equipment required for installation, checkout, diagnosis, repair and use of system. Please verify that this statement is correct, and that the contractor is not required to deliver any ST&TE as part of the deliverables.

Government response – SOW paragraph 3.4.4 does not use the word "only." Please review the SOW paragraph 3.4.4. The below requirement is incorporated into identified in section C, paragraph C.2:

"CLIN 0001 prices will include..... Reusable transit cases for all hardware being delivered using best commercial practices. Non-reusable crates for initial spare parts using best commercial practices. Support hardware (i.e. MILES SAT torque wrenches if required) will be included with the transit cases."

Offerors shall propose any special tools or support hardware required to operate or calibrate the proposed solution so that the intended training can be accomplished. Any support hardware shall be proposed within the price of CLIN 0001 and be shipped in a reusable transit case.
